DIVERSION CAN BE GRANTED FOR THE FOLLOWING CRIMES PROVIDING THE RESPONDENT/DEFENDANT QUALIFIES

Theft (felony and misdemeanor)Business or VehAttempted TheftDUI / TOC (FirsMinor in Possession of AlcoholDomestic ViolenForgeryDisorderly CondMaking a False WritingBatteryMarijuana (misdemeanor)Consumption ofCriminal Damage to PropertyInterference withTrespassingPossession of DrCriminal Use of a Weapon (Possession of Unlawful Weapons)

Business or Vehicle Burglary DUI / TOC (First Offense) Domestic Violence Battery Disorderly Conduct Battery Consumption of Alcohol by a Minor Interference with Law Enforcement Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

DIVERSION WILL <u>NOT</u> BE GRANTED FOR THE FOLLOWING CRIMES REGARDLESS OF THE RESPONDENT'S HISTORY

Kidnapping Robbery Rape Sodomy Battery of LEO Violation of a Protective Order Aggravated Battery Aggravated Robbery Indecent Liberties with a Child Lewd and Lascivious Behavior Felony Drug Charges No Proof of Insurance Aggravated Assault Aggravated Sodomy Child Abuse Sexual Battery Residential Burglary

OTHER DISQUALIFIERS:

*Prior criminal diversions. Traffic diversions do not count.

*Traffic infractions will not be diverted.

*Criminal complaints with more than five (5) consecutive counts/victims, regardless of what they are. *If the case has already been taken through a suppression hearing, diversion will not be considered. *If the case is an appeal from a conviction in a lower court, diversion will not be considered.
