### **DIVERSION CAN BE GRANTED FOR THE FOLLOWING CRIMES PROVIDING THE RESPONDENT/DEFENDANT QUALIFIES**

### **DIVERSION WILL NOT BE GRANTED FOR THE FOLLOWING CRIMES REGARDLESS OF THE RESPONDENT'S HISTORY**

### **OTHER DISQUALIFIERS:**

- \*Prior criminal diversions. Traffic diversions do not count.
- \*Traffic infractions will not be diverted.
- \*Criminal complaints with more than five (5) consecutive counts/victims, regardless of what they are.
- \*If the case has already been taken through a suppression hearing, diversion will not be considered.
- \*If the case is an appeal from a conviction in a lower court, diversion will not be considered.
