DIVERSION CAN BE GRANTED FOR THE FOLLOWING CRIMES PROVIDING THE RESPONDENT/DEFENDANT QUALIFIES

Theft (felony and misdemeanor)

Business or Vehicle Burglary

Attempted Theft DUI / TOC

Minor in Possession of Alcohol Domestic Violence Battery

Forgery Disorderly Conduct

Making a False Writing Trespassing

Marijuana (misdemeanor) Consumption of Alcohol by a Minor

Criminal Damage to Property

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (felony and misdemeanor) Criminal Use of a Weapon (Possession of Unlawful Weapons)

DIVERSION WILL <u>NOT</u> BE GRANTED FOR THE FOLLOWING CRIMES REGARDLESS OF THE RESPONDENT'S HISTORY

Battery Aggravated Battery Kidnapping Robbery Aggravated Robbery Obstruction Indecent Liberties with a Child Rape Child Abuse Lewd and Lascivious Behavior Aggravated Assault **Resisting Arrest** Sexual Battery Aggravated Sodomy Sodomy Battery of LEO Felony Drug Charges Residential Burglary Worthless Checks Violation of a Protective Order No Proof of Insurance

Interference with Law Enforcement

OTHER DISQUALIFIERS:

- *Prior criminal history/diversions. Traffic infractions do not count as prior criminal history.
- *Traffic infractions will not be diverted.
- *Continuous crimes such as forgeries or thefts committed over a period of time.
- *Criminal complaints with more than five (5) consecutive counts/victims, regardless of what they are.
- *Violation of employee/employer trust.
- *If the victim(s) insist on prosecution, diversion will be denied.
- *If the Officers involved in the case insist on prosecution, or if the defendant refused to help the officers in the investigation or otherwise failed to cooperate, diversion will be denied.
- *If the case has already been taken through a suppression hearing, diversion will not be considered.
- *If the case is an appeal from a conviction in a lower court, diversion will not be considered.
